Sailing Instructions

York River Yacht Club

Saturday, July 28, 2018 @ 13:30 EDT

Entry: Race entry is included with your YRYC Wednesday Night Race registration. Boats that are not registered for the Wednesday Night Races may compete by registering with the YRYC Race Captain by 8pm Friday July 27th via email: mmastracci@cox.net.

Classes: PHRF Non-Spinnaker only (single headsail).

Start: Between orange flag on the RC boat and York River R“22”.

Signals: Race will be started in accordance with Rule 26. Warning signal at 13:25 EDT.

Preparatory	P flag	4
One Minute	P flag removed	1
Starting	Class flag removed	0

Course: As posted on the Committee Boat. The course will be selected from the Summer Series Wednesday Night race courses as described in YRYC Race Rules & Guidelines 2018.

Finish: Between orange flag on the Committee Boat and York River R“22”.

Time Limit: Two hours. One boat finishing within the time limit constitutes a valid race for the fleet.

Protests: Notify the Committee Boat immediately upon finishing. Written protests are due by 1800 on race day at the YRYH Activities Room. Protests will be heard at 1800 on race day.

- Rules:**
- Only one person permitted aboard the boat during the race.
 - PFD must be worn from the warning signal until the boat has finished.
 - Electronic autopilots not permitted from the warning signal until the boat has finished.
 - Monitor VHF 72 for instructions or announcements from the Race Committee.

Awards: In addition to individual awards, a plaque will be added to the permanent clubhouse trophy for the Single-Handed Race. The plaque will note the year, boat, and skipper/owner's name.
